As we continue to move forward with the ministry of Rancho Sordo Mundo, we are grateful for the many ways God has allowed this place to be used as a tool for His work. Our facilities remain active throughout the year, hosting Christian camps and Deaf retreats, as well as serving local churches. One of our longest and most meaningful partnerships has been with Young Life, who have faithfully used the Ranch for over ten years. The income generated through these camps and retreats plays a vital role in helping us maintain the Ranch and continue supporting Deaf ministry projects throughout Mexico.

Looking ahead, one of our goals is to begin a **Christian Deaf Camp during the summer months**. We are prayerfully seeking churches that would like to partner with us, either through financial support or by bringing mission teams to serve alongside us. These teams would help with logistics, meal preparation, and general upkeep, while also building meaningful relationships with the Deaf community.

Through **Word Became Flesh Global**, our on-the-ground Deaf ministry in the city of Ensenada continues to respond to significant and ongoing needs within the Deaf community. God has opened many doors for service, and we are encouraged by the ways He is allowing us to walk alongside Deaf individuals and families in practical and spiritual ways.

We have continued to remodel and improve **Casa Josué**, our Deaf men's ministry home. This work has been made possible in large part through the faithful help of **Joshua and Jessica Everett**, who serve as our Project and Group Coordinators. Their leadership and dedication have been a great blessing as we work to create a safe, functional, and Christ-centered environment for the men who live there.



One of the highlights of this season has been the privilege of distributing **over 20 illustrated Bibles specifically designed for the Deaf**. These resources help make the Word of God more accessible and meaningful, allowing Scripture to connect visually and spiritually with Deaf readers.

We are also deeply grateful for **LifeBridge Church**, who have continued their faithful ministry of providing shoes to Deaf families and individuals in need. This practical act of love has made a tangible difference and continues to be a powerful expression of Christ's care.

Please pray for us as we begin planning for a **Deaf Christian Camp**, tentatively scheduled for **July**. We ask for wisdom, provision, and the right partnerships as we prepare this opportunity for fellowship, spiritual growth, and community for the Deaf.

Guatemala Deaf Ministries Update

This past year at Guatemala Deaf Ministries has been a testimony of God’s faithfulness. Despite challenges, the Lord blessed the ministry with growth, strong teamwork, and meaningful outreach. Students and families gathered regularly for fellowship and celebrations, including Family Day, Guatemala’s Independence Day, and special outings that brought joy and community to the children. A well-attended graduation ceremony marked important academic milestones, with several PRONEA students advancing in their middle school studies. Spiritually, the year was especially encouraging.

Six individuals were baptized during Fellowship Sunday, and teaching continued for pastors and church leaders through the *Todos a la Mesa* conference, equipping churches to better minister to the Deaf. Staff retreats, cultural celebrations, and events such as the annual Passover (Seder) dinner strengthened unity and vision.

Ongoing facility improvements, including new gates, have enhanced both security and the ministry’s presence in the community. The ministry remains grateful for volunteers, supporters, and prayer partners who make this work possible. As the year closes, Guatemala Deaf Ministries looks ahead with hope, trusting God to continue using this ministry to teach the Deaf to reach the Deaf for Jesus Christ.



Josefina Health Update

It has now been over a year since **Josefina Everett** suffered her stroke. While her recovery continues to be slow, we are grateful for the progress she has made in regaining some mobility. Josefina is still receiving outpatient physical therapy several times a week, and this ongoing care has been an important part of her rehabilitation.

To help meet daily needs, a caregiver now comes four times a week to assist **Luke Everett**, allowing him time to take care of other responsibilities around the Ranch. This support has been a great help as Luke continues to serve as Josefina’s primary caregiver.

We ask for continued prayer for Josefina’s **cognitive health**, as she has become more forgetful and at times confused. We are in ongoing follow-up with her neurologist to determine the next steps for addressing and rehabilitating her mental function. Despite these challenges, we remain thankful for the progress we have seen and for God’s faithfulness throughout this journey.

Please also continue to pray for **Luke Everett**, for strength, endurance, and encouragement as he cares for Josefina each day. We are also trusting the Lord to continue providing the necessary funds to cover the weekly caregiver support and physical therapy.
