



Dear Friends,


We hope this season you are doing well and reminded of the hope and joy that is brought through the birth of our savior Jesus Christ this Christmas.

Here is an update from a ministry we support in Ensenada:

We currently have been slowly remodeling our Deaf men's home called Casa Josué, which is run by Carlos Suarez. At the home we have six Deaf men. Some are furthering their education, others are saving money to be able to become independent homeowners, and some like Jose Antonio have a desire to be trained up to serve in ministry or become a Deaf pastor.

Furthermore, we recently were able to sign a contract and rent a home for our women's housing ministry called Casa Maravillas, which is run by our housing director Frances

Vázquez. As of this moment, we have one Deaf women living there, who used to be a former student of RSM: Miriam. Our goal with these homes is to train up strong, independent, spirit-led Deaf men and women by providing opportunities to continue their education, to have access to jobs with livable wages, and to grow spiritually within a Christian community at our local church.

We were also able to come alongside financially another former student, Ana Lidia, who had a premature baby and needed hospital and medical expenses covered. After a month in the NICU, Ana Lidia was able to take her healthy baby daughter home.

Other areas where we serve the Deaf in Ensenada include providing school supplies for the Deaf association, distributing food packages for low-income Deaf families and individuals, and provide interpreting services when the need arises.

We could have not done these things alone, which is why we are grateful for everyone involved in our ministry.

However, since the pandemic hit, they moved back to Guadalupe, where he is currently renting a house and driving Reynaldo back and forth to school in Ensenada. Unfortunately, in the recent months, Mark's health has been slowly declining to a point where he requires assisted living. Reynaldo moved back to his mother's in Tijuana for the time being. In the meantime, Luke & Ed are taking care of Mark and visiting him several times a week, making sure he eats and keeping him company until we find a more permanent place for him.

We ask that you pray for Mark's health and mind as he navigates this next step in his life, and wisdom for us to be able to lovingly come alongside him and help him.
